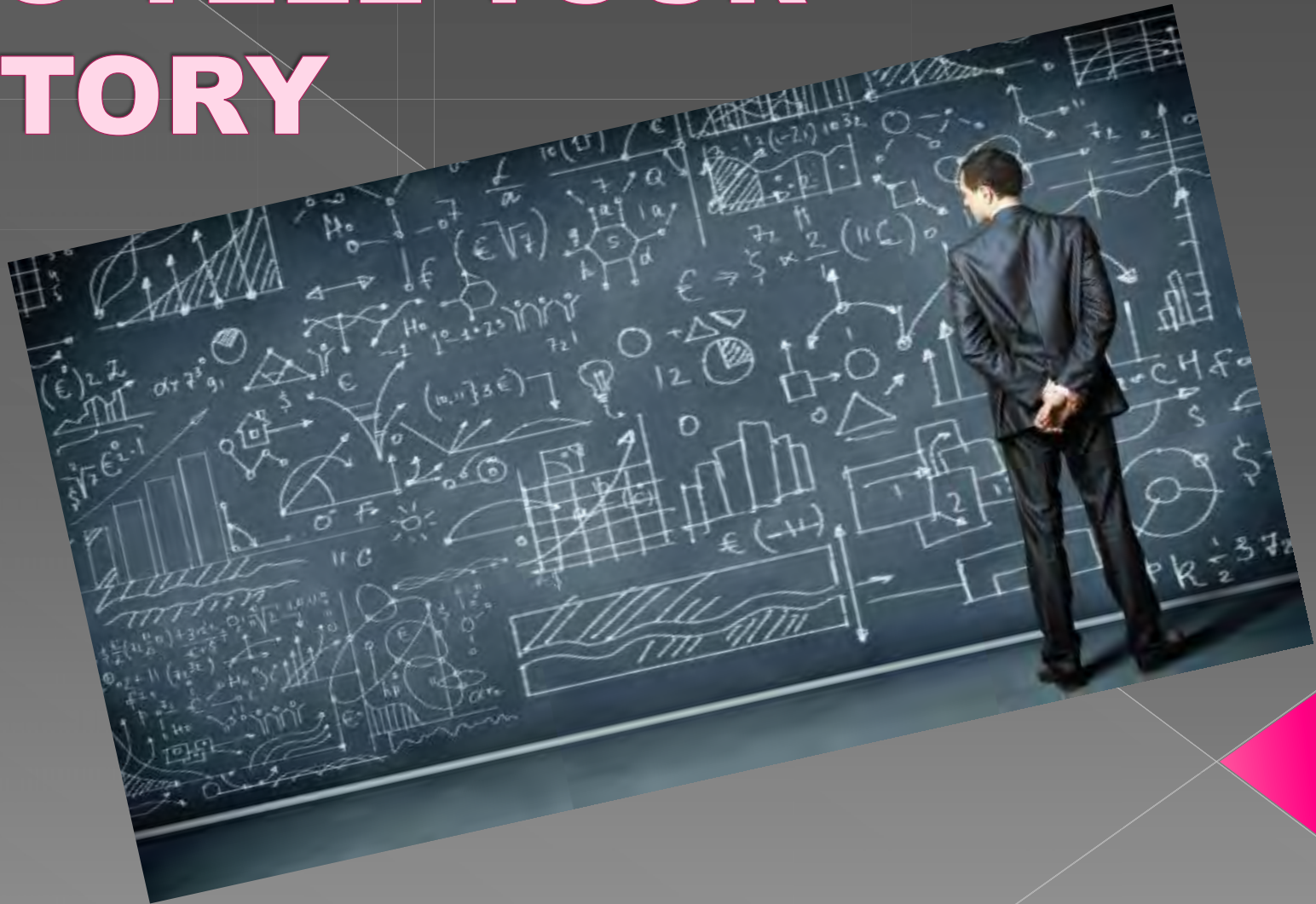

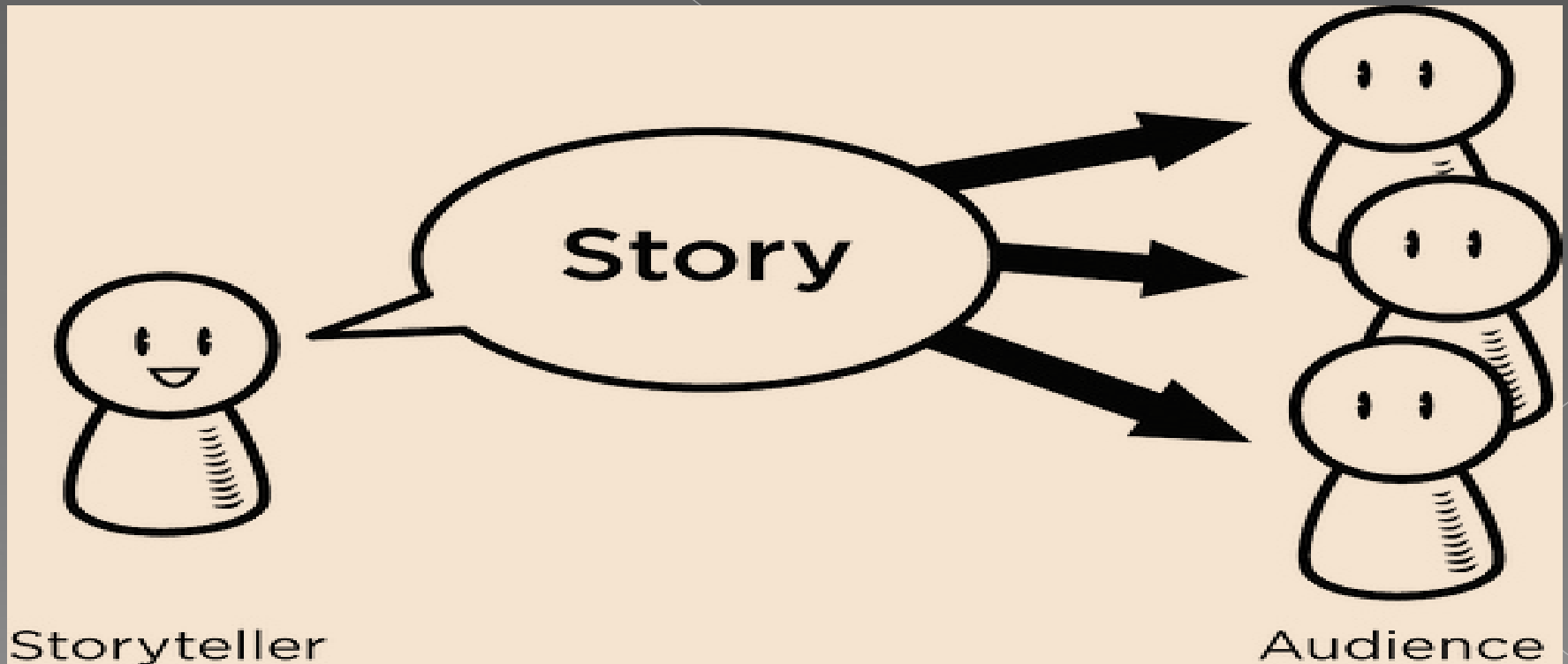
EVERY SCHOOL DISTRICT HAS STORIES TO TELL

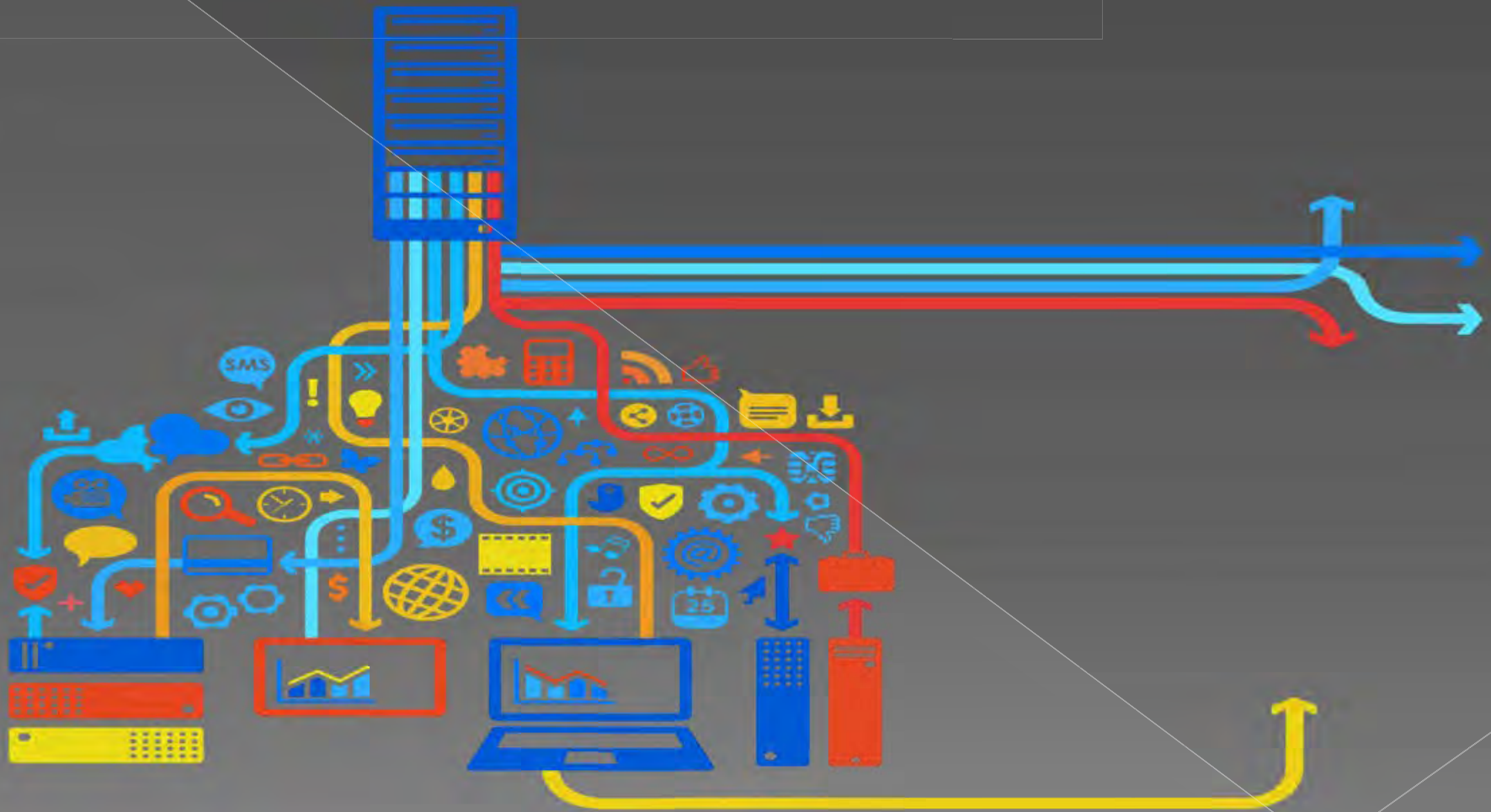

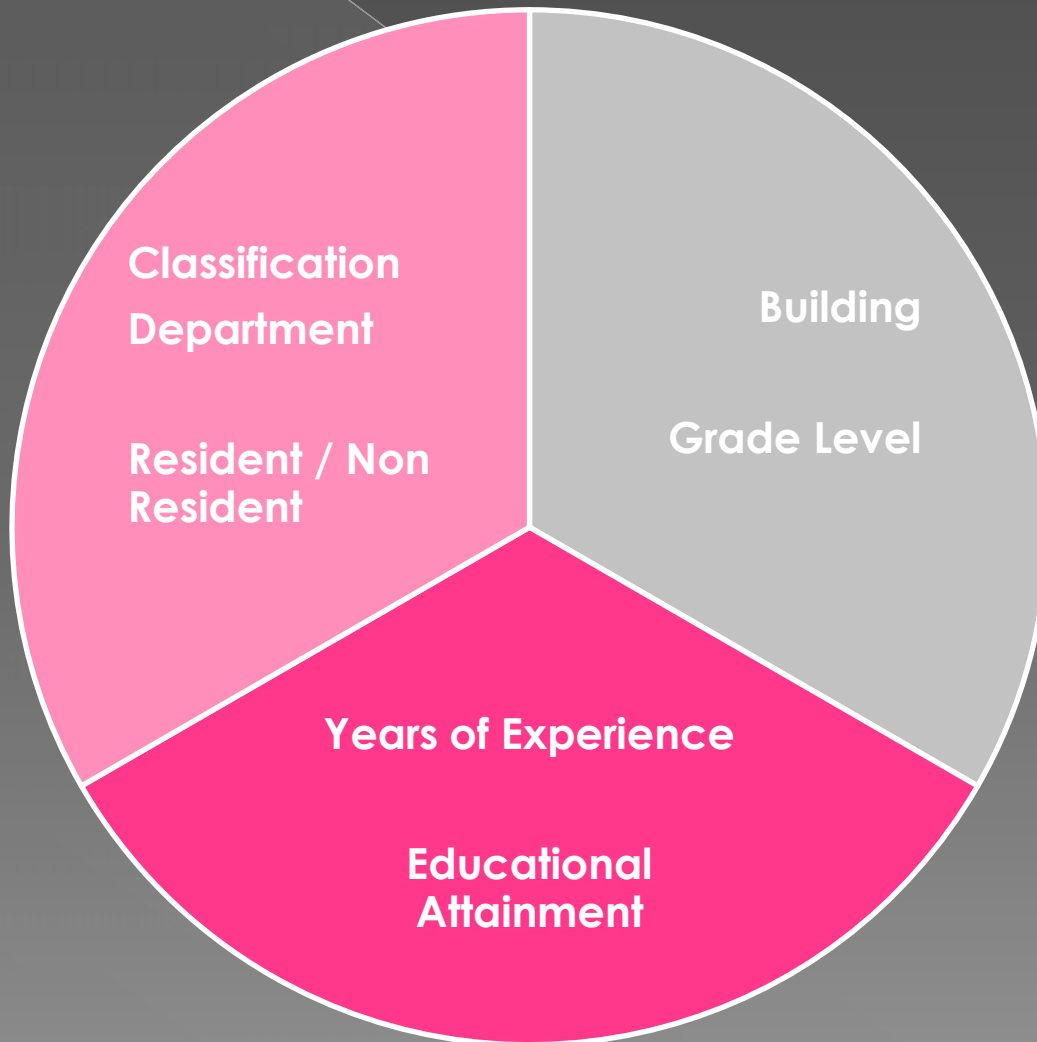

 - Visual & Graphic Arts, Musical Arts, Theater Arts

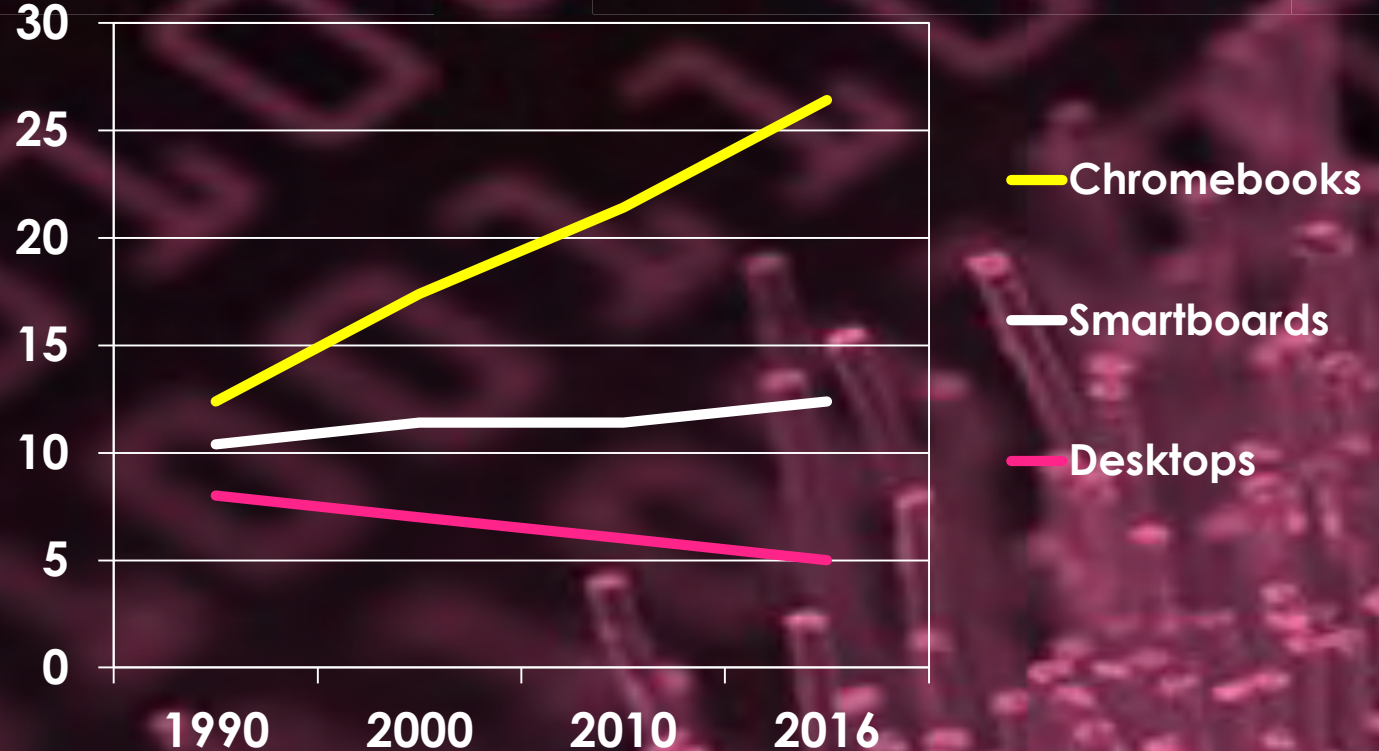

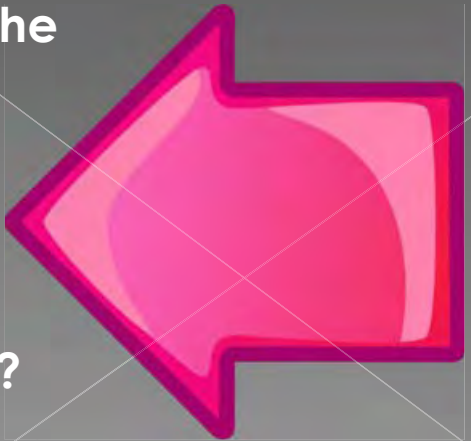


Some of the most remembered presentations are centered around unusual topics
