Southeast Ohio school board member receives association's highest honor

COLUMBUS — A Muskingum County school board member will receive the Ohio School Boards Association's most prestigious award.

Gail Requardt, who has served on the East Muskingum Local Board of Education for 27 years and the Mid-East Career and Technology Centers board since 2003, will be recognized as a 2018 All-Ohio School Board member on Sunday, Nov. 11, during the OSBA Capital Conference and Trade Show in Columbus. OSBA Chief Executive Officer Richard Lewis will introduce All-Ohio School Board members on the first day of the 63rd annual conference, a three-day convention attended by more than 9,000 Ohio public school board members, administrators and other education stakeholders.

Each year, OSBA names one board of education member from each of its five regions — Central, Northeast, Northwest, Southeast and Southwest — to the All-Ohio School Board. The award recognizes outstanding service to public education and represents the dedication shown by thousands of board members across the state.

All-Ohio School Board candidates are nominated by their respective school boards. OSBA regional committees then select the five winners.

Requardt, a New Concord resident and occupational therapist with HealthPRO/Heritage, represents OSBA's Southeast Region. Seven times she has been elected to the East Muskingum board and currently serves as its president. She has served as president or vice president of her respective boards 19 times.
