Southeast Ohio students to perform at premier state education conference

COLUMBUS — Students from Waverly City Schools will perform at the Ohio School Boards Association (OSBA) 2019 Student Achievement Fair in Columbus. Waverly High School Polarity is one of five groups selected to perform at the fair — a highlight of OSBA's 64th annual Capital Conference and Trade Show, which runs Nov. 10-12 at the Greater Columbus Convention Center.

Representing the Southeast Region, the vocal group, under the direction of Matthew Radford, will perform Monday, Nov. 11, from 11:05 a.m. to 11:25 a.m. in the convention center's Hall B. The Student Achievement Fair features 100 original projects and programs created by Ohio public schools.
