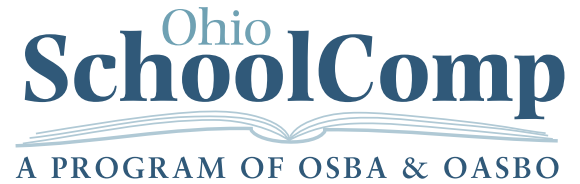


Ohio SchoolComp offering Ohio workers' compensation programs to members of the Ohio Association of School Business Officials and the Ohio School Boards Association
